CERTIFICATION FLOWCHART

Step 1:

Contact QCS(E) requesting information about certification against an Australian or International Standard

Step 2:

QCS(E) sends you a Request for Quotation Form. You complete the form and return it to QCS(E).

Step 3:

QCS(E) provides you with a fixed price quotation for the 3 year program. Upon acceptance of the quotation, you progress to the Stage 1 audit.



Step 5:

QCS(E) schedules the Stage 2 audit. Once this audit is completed successfully, QCS(E) issues you with a formal certificate.

Step 4:

QCS(E) schedules the Stage 1 Audit. The audit is conducted and a comprehensive report is provided to you.

Certification is a two stage process.

Stage 1 Audit

A QCS(E) auditor visits your facility to ensure that all key business activities have been included in the system documentation. Our auditor will advise you of any issues requiring attention as part of the report provided. This is an opportunity for you to ask questions about the Stage 2 audit.

Stage 2 Audit

This is the formal certification audit. The QCS(E) auditor will assess implementation of the system within your business and compliance with the requirements of your chosen Standard. Once this audit has been completed successfully, QCS(E) will issue a certificate of registration to you.
